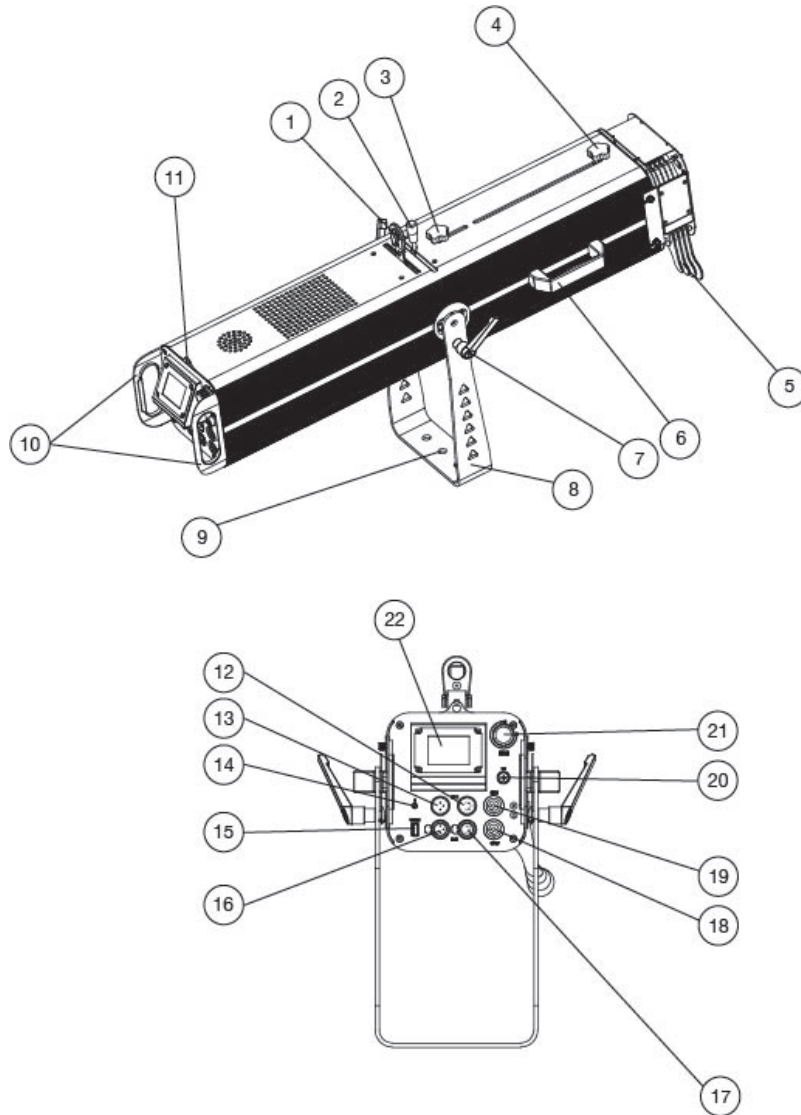

INSTALLATION

FLAMMABLE MATERIAL WARNING!

Keep drive a minimum of 5.0 feet (1.5m) away from flammable material and/or pyrotechnics.

ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

A qualified electrician should be used for all electrical connections and/or installations.

DO NOT INSTALL THE DEVICE IF YOU ARE NOT QUALIFIED TO DO SO!

The unit **MUST** be installed following all local, national, and country commercial electrical and construction codes and regulations.

Before installing or mounting any device, a professional equipment installer **MUST** be consulted to determine whether the mounting structure or surface is properly certified to safely support the combined weight of the fixture, clamps, cables, and accessories.

Overhead fixture installations must always be secured with a secondary safety attachment, such as an appropriately rated safety cable that meets all local, national, and country codes and regulations.

Ambient operating temperature range is from **14°F to 113°F (-10°C to 45°C)**. Do not operate this device when ambient temperature falls outside this range.

This fixture should be installed in areas outside walking paths, seating areas, or away from areas where unauthorized personnel might be able to reach the device by hand.

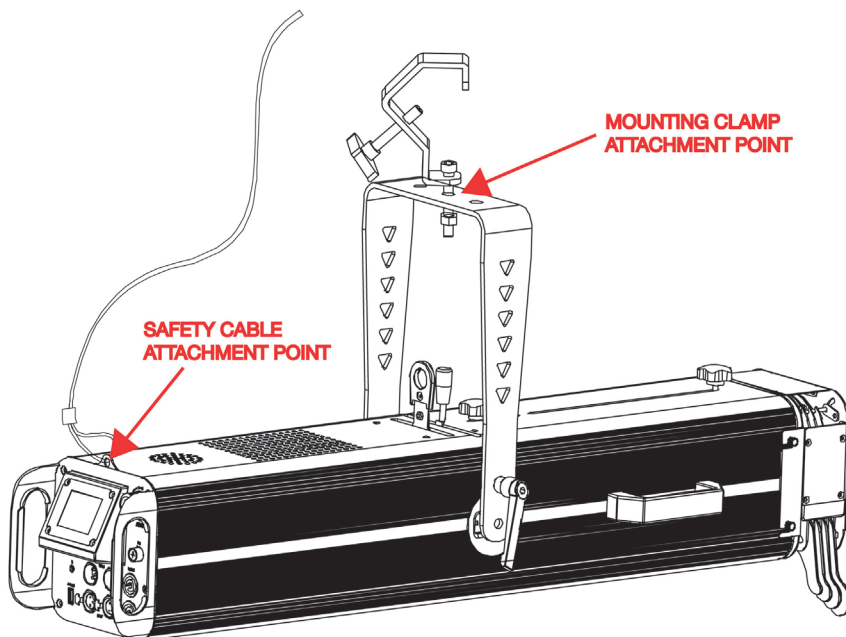
NEVER stand directly below the fixture when rigging, removing, or servicing.

Allow approximately 15 minutes for the fixture to cool down before servicing.

INSTALLATION

CLAMP INSTALLATION

This fixture features a mounting clamp attachment point, which is located on the mounting yoke, as well as a safety cable rigging point, located near the display screen (see the illustration below). When mounting the fixture to a truss or any other suspended or overhead installation, be sure to secure an appropriately rated clamp (not included) to the clamp attachment point and attach a separate **SAFETY CABLE** of the appropriate safety rating to the safety cable rigging point.



SAFETY CABLE

ALWAYS ATTACH A SAFETY CABLE WHENEVER INSTALLING THIS FIXTURE IN A SUSPENDED ENVIRONMENT TO ENSURE THAT THE FIXTURE WILL NOT FALL IF THE CLAMP FAILS.

RIGGING

Overhead rigging requires extensive experience, including but not limited to: calculating working load limits, understanding the installation material being used, and periodic safety inspection of all installation material and the fixture itself. If you lack these qualifications, do not attempt to perform the installation yourself. Improper installation can result in bodily injury.

UC IR REMOTE

The **UC IR (sold separately)** infrared remote gives you control of various functions. To control the fixture, you must aim the remote at the front of the fixture and be within the maximum range of 30 feet.

Please note that the device must be in primary mode in order to enable UC IR remote control.



There are many factors that can affect and/or interrupt a wireless signal, including walls, glass, metal, objects, and people. Therefore, the following guidelines are recommended in order to maximize the chances of having a clear path for the wireless signal to reach the device:

- Install the device a minimum of 9.8 ft (3m) above audiences and/or ground level.
- Arrange the wireless antenna in an upright, vertical position.
- Position devices in direct line of sight of the transmitting controller.

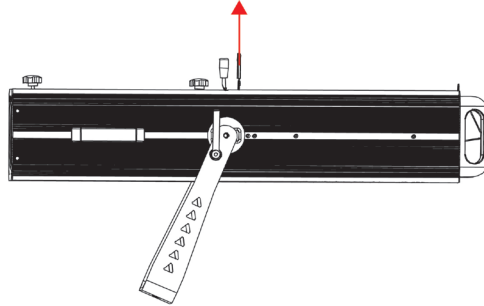
Careful planning and testing of the selected installation location is critical in order to ensure optimized, reliable wireless operation.



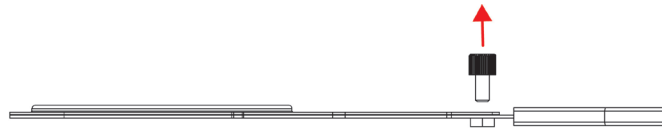
GOBO INSTALLATION

In order to install and use the included Gobo Holder, follow the directions shown below:

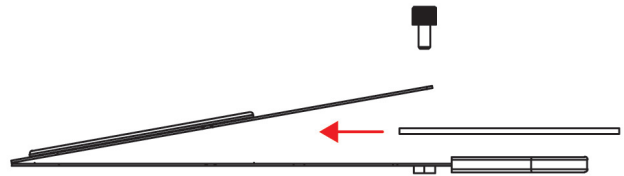
1. Remove the Gobo Holder from its slot. The Gobo Holder handle is the ring-shaped item located just aft of the Iris Adjustment lever.



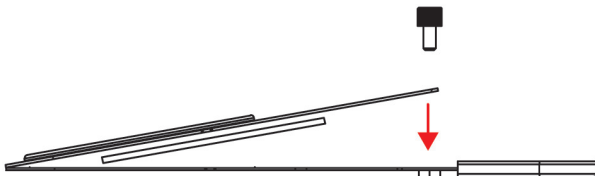
2. Unscrew the retainer screw from the Gobo Holder.



3. Open up the Gobo Holder. Slide the Glass Gobo between the two halves of the Gobo Holder, making sure that the Glass Gobo has been placed securely in its cutout.



4. Close the Gobo Holder. Replace and tighten the retainer screw.

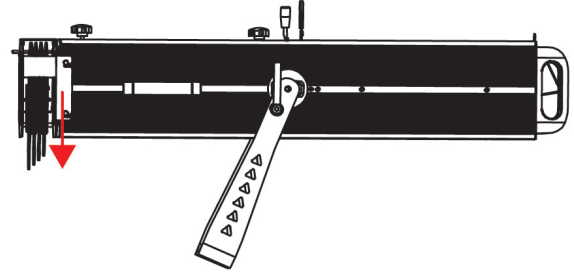
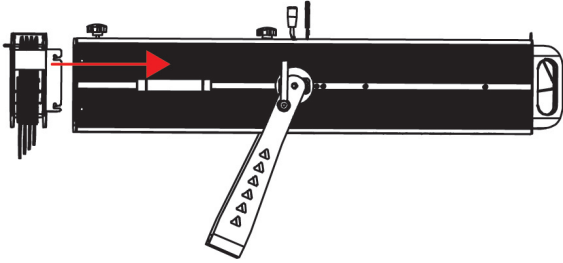


5. Re-insert the Gobo Holder back into its slot on the fixture. Make sure that the retainer screw on the Gobo Holder is facing backwards (towards the control screen).

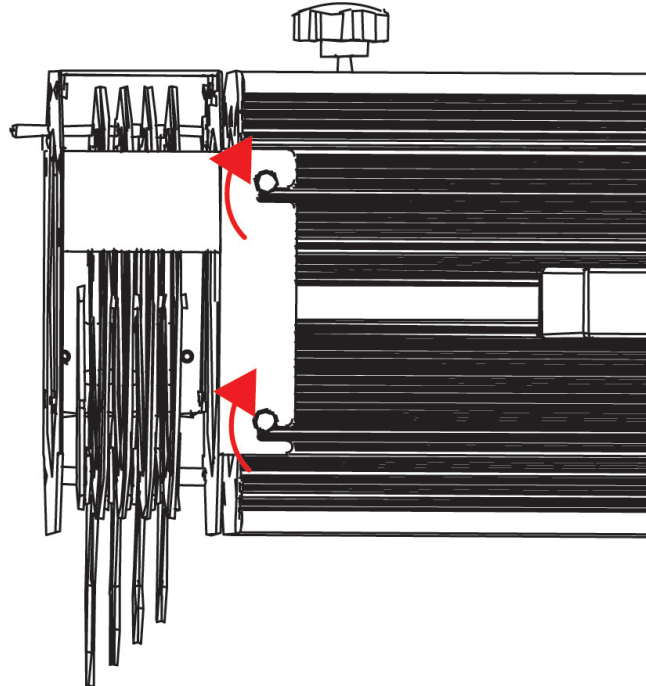
4-SLOT BOOMERANG

A 4-slot Boomerang attachment is included in with this device. Follow the steps listed below to install this accessory onto your device.

1. Slide the 4-slot Boomerang onto the lens end of the fixture. Hook the installation bracket of the 4-slot Boomerang over the thumb screws. The notched slots on the installation bracket of the 4-slot Boomerang should slide on smoothly and then drop down into place over the thumb screws.



2. Tighten the thumb screws to secure the 4-slot Boomerang in place.

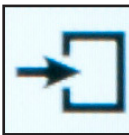
The device includes an easy to navigate system menu that can be accessed via controls on the touchscreen display panel.

MANUAL MODE



The screen shown above is displayed when Manual Mode is selected from the main system menu. Operation of the fixture in Manual Mode is outlined below:

Fade ON: Defines the period of time during which the fixture will ramp up when the **ON** button is selected. Value can be changed using the **UP** and **DOWN** buttons. Allowable values range from 0.0 to 30.0 seconds, in 0.1 second intervals.

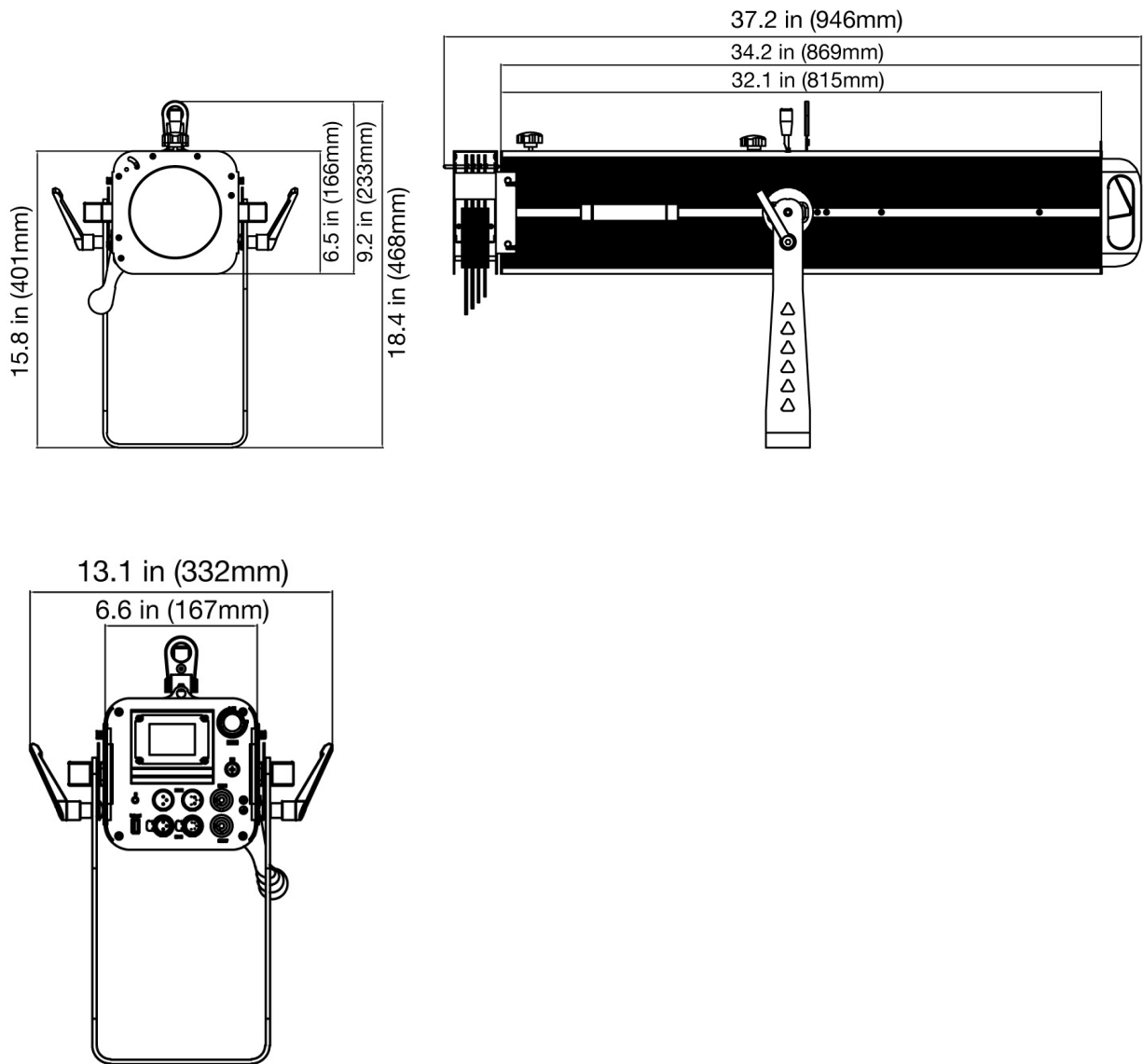
Fade OFF: Defines the period of time during which the fixture will ramp down when the **OFF** button is selected. Value can be changed using the **UP** and **DOWN** buttons. Allowable values range from 0.0 to 30.0 seconds, in 0.1 second intervals.

Intensity: Value is adjusted using the intensity knob located to the right of the display screen. Allowable values range from 0 to 100%, in increments of 1%.

PRG: Toggles between the **Fade ON** and **Fade OFF** settings.

ON / OFF: Switches the main lamp on or off. Note that the ramp time corresponds to the values defined in the **Fade ON** and **Fade OFF** settings.
